

During the months of October, November & December, clients of the Animal Medical Center (AMC) in Woodland Park, owned and operated by Drs. Mike and Brittany Factor, donated money to the Pet Food Pantry (PFP). Based on the amount of money collected (\$264), Royal Canin Pet Food Co. donated pet food and AMC, Dr. Factor, matched the dollars. He gave the Pet Food Pantry a check for \$264.

The Pet Food Pantry for TC, a 501c3, has been providing supplemental dog and cat food to pet owners struggling financially or in a short term emergency situation since January 2009. It is a volunteer organization with no paid staff. In 2016, it distributed 21,300 lbs. of dog food, 6,000 lbs. of cat food, and 2,300 bags of treats. This food helped keep pets with their owners. For many older people, their pet is their "Best Friend".
